C. Course Description and Objectives

1. Course Description

This is the first of two clinical courses in endodontics. In this course, students will be taught how to:

- 1. Practicing to perform endodontic treatment on patients.
- 2. Follow infection control measures.
- 3. Systematic diagnosis is achieved to reach the best treatment plan.
- Prescribe drugs indicated for better prognosis.

2. Course Main Objective

- Organize clinical findings, symptoms and pain history to determine a diagnosis of endodontic pain.
- Perform different tests to determine pulp vitality including cold test, percussion test and others.
- Plan and deliver routine non-surgical endodontic treatment to patients with pulpal and periapical diseases.

3. Course Objectives

By the end of this course, students should be able to:

- Describe the etiology, pathology, clinical features, and management of common pulpal and periapical diseases.
- Identify the different principles, techniques, materials, and medications used in endodontic practice.
- Perform different clinical root canal treatment on multi-rooted teeth in the preclinical settings.
- Discern and manipulate different instruments, equipment, and materials for endodontic treatment.
- Demonstrate ethical, professional, and legal responsibilities in dentistry profession.
- Establish collaborative teamwork and leadership responsibility in dental practice.
