Practicing to perform endodontic treatment on patients. 2. Follow infection control measures. 3. Systematic diagnosis is achieved to reach the best treatment plan. 4. Prescribe drugs indicated for better prognosis.

Course Main Objective</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Organize clinical findings, symptoms and pain history to determine a diagnosis of endodontic pain. • Perform different tests to determine pulp vitality including cold test, percussion test and others. • Plan and deliver routine non-surgical endodontic treatment to patients with pulpal and periapical diseases.

Course Objectives</p> <p>By the end of this course, students should be able to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Describe the etiology, pathology, clinical features, and management of common pulpal and periapical diseases. • Identify the different principles, techniques, materials, and medications used in endodontic practice. • Perform different clinical root canal treatment on multi-rooted teeth in the preclinical settings. • Discern and manipulate different instruments, equipment, and materials for endodontic treatment. • Demonstrate ethical, professional, and legal responsibilities in dentistry profession. • Establish collaborative teamwork and leadership responsibility in dental practice.
