Attention is given to efficient utilization of the clinical facilities and the need for proper patient record and clinical record systems. The students are expected to carry out simple restorative procedures under close staff supervision.</p>
<p>2. Course Main Objective</p> <p>It will be directed towards the clinical applications of the principles of different cavity preparation as well as the different types of restorative materials.</p>

Course Objectives</p> <p>By the end of this course, students should be able to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Remember different instruments, technique of their use for isolation, cavity preparation and restoration Discuss diagnosis, treatment plan for operative case Discuss steps of all cavity preparations and restorations Formulate dental treatment plan based on diagnostic findings for dental caries and patient history Select and use the appropriate restorative material perform rubber dam isolation, minimally invasive operative procedures, placement and finishing of restorative materials to reconstruct and restore the tooth back to its normal shape, form and function Establish collaborative teamwork and leadership responsibility in dental clinic Demonstrate, and apply the principles of professional behaviour including honesty, confidentiality, and respect in clinical practice
