C. Course Description and Objectives

1. Course Description

- This is a two-credit hour course
- The course consists of didactic and clinical components. The didactic component addresses the different aspects diagnosing, managing and treating problems of pre-school and school age children.
- The clinical component is the first clinical course in pediatric dentistry. The course offers one session of 3 hours/ week for one semester. It is clinical setting in which the student acquires the motor skills necessary to render care for children. The student should have an opportunity to perform the clinical procedures commonly associated with children's dentistry.

The concept of comprehensive care will be adapted so that the student develops an awareness of and appreciation for the total child. Child Patient with different age will be selected according to course requirement.

The main purpose of this course is to provide the dental students with the knowledge and skills that would enable them to properly assess and manage pediatric patients, and perform diagnosis and different dental procedures
