C. Course Description and objectives

1. Course Description

This course consists of theoretical and clinical components, the theoretical phase provides the dental students with the clinical steps and techniques required for management of completely and partially edentulous patients with conventional removable prosthesis. The clinical phase provides dental students with the chance to practice all the clinical steps required to fabricate a removable prosthesis, for completely or partially edentulous patients, under control supervision in the faculty clinics.

2. Course Main Objective

The main objective of this course is to enable the dental students to drop the acquired theoretical knowledge of Removable Prosthodontics into the clinical practice, to treat edentulous patients under control supervision in the faculty clinics.

3. Course Objectives

- Discuss the significance of the diagnostic finding on the treatment plan.
- Describe the different clinical steps for partial and complete denture construction.

- Formulate a treatment plan for patients indicated for removable prosthesis.
- Perform all the clinical steps for removable denture construction.
- Manipulate different materials used during clinical management of removable prosthesis.
- Demonstrate ethics and professionalism in dental practice.
- Show proper time and resources management in clinical dental practice.
- Express effective communications with the patients and other members in the dental clinics.
