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C. Course Description and objectives

1. Course Description

This course is pure clinical course, which is given in the form of 3 hours' clinical session once a week, to give dental students the chance to treat edentulous patients. This course is concerned with the principles of managing partially and totally edentulous patients by using removable dental prosthesis starting from diagnosis until delivery of the prosthesis & completion of follow-up visits.

2. Course Main Objective

The main objective of the course is to provide the dental students with the skills that would enable them to manage completely & partially edentulous patients under controlled supervision in the faculty clinics.

3. Course Objectives

By the end of this course, students should be able to:

- Discuss the significance of the diagnostic finding on the treatment plan for removable partial or complete denture cases.
- Describe the different clinical and lab steps for partial and complete denture construction.
- Recognize the causes of patient complaints after removable denture insertion.
- Use all the necessary diagnostic measures and formulate a treatment plan for edentulous patients for the provision of removable prosthesis.
- Perform all the clinical steps necessary for removable denture construction.
- Manipulate different materials and instruments that are required during management of edentulous patients with removable dentures.
- Manage common patient complaints after removable denture insertion.
- Demonstrate ethics and professionalism in dental practice.
- Show proper time and resources management in clinical dental practice.
- Express effective communications with the patients and other members in the dental clinics.
